This report must be received by the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board in Montgomery, Alabama on or before the first day of the month following the month after the end of the previous quarter for each wine shipment. [20-X-9-.08]

Quarterly due dates:

January 1 - March 31 due May 1
April 1 - June 30 due August 1
July 1 - September 30 due November 1
October 1 - December 31 due February 1

Common or Permit Carrier Name: Trade name.

Contact Person: Name of contact person if we have any questions about this report. If that person has changed since your last report, please check the box for new contact.

E-mail Address: E-mail address of the contact person listed above.
