Barrel #: 7544597

Nose: Dark cherry and toasted notes.

Palate: Peppercorn and slight notes of orchard fruits.

Finish: Finishes high in the throat with slight lingering in the chest.

Proof: 109

Mashbill: 73%-78% Corn, 12% Malt & 10%-15% Rye
